

LESSON PLAN

Age Group: 5-6 Years

Duration of Lesson: 40 mins

Subject: Social Studies Integrated With Comprehension

Topic: How to Fly a Kite

Objectives:

1. Have students create a story about 'Kite Flying'.
2. Get students to help construct 5 questions for the story orally.

Teaching Strategies:

- Discussion
- Guided Reading
- Echo Reading
- Drawing
- Teacher Modelling
- Question and Answer

Materials/Technology:

- Pencil & book
- Kite
- Picture
- Chalkboard
- Multimedia Projector
- Bristol Board with squawariona

Set Induction:

- Show the students an actual kite
- Ask the students is done with a kite
- Ask the children to describe what is happening in the picture
- Ask what they would do with the kite

Learning Experiences

- Create a story from the ideas the students come up with.
- Get the students to make up at least five sentences about the items.
- Create the sentences from the ideas the students give.
- Place sentences strips on the board as the story is developed
- Ask students to put the story in sequence on the board.
- When you have enough sentences to tell the story.
- Read the story to the students.
- Then you get them to do some echo reading.

Assessment:

- Get students to make up questions for the story.
- Ask the students to give the answers to the questions orally.

Closure:

- Ask students to draw a picture to tell the story.

Follow-up

- Take the students outside and allow them to fly the kite.
