

## Lesson Plan

Age Group: 4 -5 years old

Duration: 35 mins

Subject: Vocabulary & Word Building Integrated with Story telling

Topic: 'at' family

### Objectives

Pupils should be able to:

- Recognise and spell words that end in the 'at' sound
- Listen to the story so they can identify the words from the story read
- Explain what these words all have in common (end in the same sound)
- Identify some other words that are related to the 'at' family

### Teaching strategies

- Question & Answer
- Illustrating
- Discussion
- Demonstration

## **Set Induction**

- Read while showing a story to the children in power point made up of 'at' words.
- Ask the students to say the names of the pictures.
- Tell them to listen to the letter sounds they are hearing in the words.
- Let students say the word for the picture.
- Ask them to sound out the letters so that they can hear the letter sounds.
- Put the sounds together and say the sound.
- Repeat the sounds a few times.

## **Learning Experiences**

- Recognising words that end in 'at'
- Identifying words that end in the 'at' sound or that belong to the 'at' family
- Matching to pictures to words
- Circling the picture from the 'at' family

## **Activity**

- Matching of the word to the picture
- Building the word
- Seat work activity – worksheet
- Teach students a song about the 'at' family
- Use a statistoscope for students to form words

## **Evaluation**

- Worksheet activity
- Statistocope where children come up and slide up or down and say which word he/she forms
