

Lesson Plan

Age Group: 5- 6

Duration: 40 minutes

Subject: Vocabulary

Topic: The sound represented by the consonant diagraph 'sh'

Objectives

Pupils should be able to:

1. Articulate the sound represented by the consonant diagraph 'sh'

Teaching strategies

- Guided Reading
- Discussion
- Questioning & Answer

Technology/Materials

Laptop Pencil & crayon Multimedia projector
Worksheets Power Point

Set Induction

- Provide a display of pictures with the 'sh' sound.
- Ask the students to name the pictures encouraging them to pronounce the word correctly.
- Display a poem
- Get students to focus on the poem.

Learning Experiences

- Read the poem to the students
- Ask students what they notice about the poem
- Draw their attention to the 'sh' words.
- Ask students to make the sound 'sh' makes.
- Ask students for the 'sh' words found in the poem.
- Ask students to make a sentence containing the 'sh' sound.

Assessment

- Distribute a worksheet with identify pictures with the 'sh' sound.
- Ask students to write two sentences with 'sh' in it.

Evaluation

- Worksheet activity

Closure

- Ask students to state what sound they studied in the lesson.

Follow-up

Have students repeat the rhyme – Shelly sells seashells

Shelly sells sea shells
By the sea shore,
The shells Shelly sells,
Are surely sea shells
So if she sells shells
On the seashore,
I am sure she sells sea shore shells
